Re: Facility usage (Huron Park Arena) at no cost

We are formally requesting to Council for CMHA Middlesex to utilize space within the arena for the purpose of offering outreach to that community. We would be providing a point of connection and engagement for anyone seeking information, referral, advocacy regarding mental health and other support services that are offered in the county.

We have been offering a hub of services at one of the empty houses every Tuesday from 1:00-4:00 since April 1<sup>st</sup>. We have had a great response in bringing the mental health services there to the people who are unable to access services that we provide in Exeter. Unfortunately the Park has been purchased by a new owner who does not support our involvement there. We are aware that there is still a need in that area and refer to the recent suicide just a couple of weeks ago. We are extending ourselves to this area with no additional funding available to us and only using the staff resources that we currently have. I am requesting that we can utilize some space in the local arena for the same time frame of Tuesday afternoons. CMHA Middlesex and staff are fully insured to provide services off site, however we have no monies to contribute towards rental etc.

The staff will be responsible for the area they use and restore it after we leave with clean up etc.

We would like to restart the hub at the arena in September if all goes smoothly.
