Purpose:

To set the date and appoint the members for the Court of Revision for the Morrissey, Fleming-Morrissey and Regan Municipal Drains 2018.

Background and Analysis:

The Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, requires a Court of Revision be held for the purpose of receiving appeals to the assessments for drainage work, as set out in the engineer's report. The Court may have three (3) or five (5) members, and must be held at least twenty (20) days after but not more than thirty (30) days after mailing the notice.

A provisional By-law is provided in the By-Law portion of the agenda for first and second readings to adopt the Engineer's Report, as presented by William

J. Dietrich, P.Eng., Engineer for the Morrissey, Fleming-Morrissey and Regan Municipal Drains 2018. A copy of the provisional By-law and the Notice of the Court of Revision must be sent to the Municipality of North Middlesex, the other municipality affected and the owners of lands assessed or given compensation or allowances in the report.
