The ongoing need for a bigger archives facility in Huron County.

Many of us personally know of wonderful collections that will be lost if there is no place for them to be received. What can we do about this?

Background: An Ad Hoc Committee Of Volunteers Representing Interested Organizations completed an indepth study of archives in the surrounding area, made a list of collections that would need to be preserved, and offered several options. This report was presented to Huron County Council in 2012, the same year the Strategic Plan for the Huron County Museum was tabled and approved by County Council. That plan is nearing completion and staff had been systematically working through the strategic objectives. The collections are being reviewed and material that is not related to Huron is being found homes in other museums. We as members of the historical community need to encourage (push!) the political will to create an archives that will help the Museum and Huron County excel at preserving our history.
