Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Council requested more detailed information on the financial impact of the MOU's approved to date, including in-kind costs.

During 2019 budget deliberations Council adopted the following resolution;

That any Registered Charity in South Huron be exempt for payment of fees related to the rental of South Huron facilities for special events.

All of the events hosted at the SHRC require staff resources in addition to the set up and tear down of the table and chairs, as staff are scheduled during the event. At the present time the fees and charges bylaw has not been amended to reflect fees associated with the set-up of any special events that would require use of staff. The operational and financial impact related to staff time for the events listed has not been tracked and is unknown for the purposes of this report.

The amount of staff time and resources will vary based on the scope of the event. The costs associated with the facilities are estimates and may vary dependent on the scope of the event (hours of usage/expected attendance).

The in-kind amount listed in the chart (\$10,056.00) related to the exemption of facility rental fees for Registered Charities is based on events that occurred in 2019.

The chart includes the financial impact (\$12,458.00) of facility rentals paid by the municipality for other organizations which do not have an MOU and are non-registered charities in 2019.
