The County's Housing Services is proposing to utilize the funding received they have received under the Ontario Priorities Housing Initiative (OPHI) allocation to develop and construct 4 one-bedroom units in Exeter.

The project is currently in the design stage, and Housing Services will seek approvals from both the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, and the County of Huron's County Council, once the design and cost estimates are finalized.

The units are proposed to be an addition to an existing apartment building, and will help to provide much needed affordable housing in our community.
