Project Proposal Title:

Equipment Replacement to support healthy aging and Senior inclusion in lawn bowling

Project Description:

The Exeter Lawn Bowling Club would like to replace our aging greens mower, and some of our essential bowling equipment. A quality mower is required to maintain the green at a faster green speed. For the senior bowlers faster greens require less effort to deliver the bowl and helps accommodate players with physical limitations. This allows them to compete on an equal basis with younger players. We would like to purchase 10 sets of size 00 bowls and 5 sets of 000 bowls. These sizes are smaller and lighter than any of our current club equipment and better suited to the physical requirements of seniors. Purchasing this quantity of smaller bowls will allow us to offer group lessons when introducing new players to the sport. We would also like to purchase 5 bowl launchers and 5 lifters which help players with mobility or balance issues, carriers for the new bowls, coaching aids, and new jacks.

Your consideration of this request is greatly appreciated. One of the requirements of the New Horizons Grant Process is that the organization must demonstrate they have the support of their community to be considered. A reply by email would be great.
