Background and Analysis:

The purpose of this report is to inform Council on Fire Department activity for the period between October 1 & December 31, 2021.

Emergency Calls

Below is a chart illustrating the number and type of call by station for the 2021 fourth quarter responses. Call types are as follows:

Structure Fire includes any type of fire attached to a free standing structure (house, barn, garden shed, fence etc).

Medical Response includes assisting EMS with VSA, Unconscious Patients or Industrial and Farm Accidents.

CO – Carbon Monoxide Other includes, arcing hydro wires or unfounded emergency calls
