- Further clarification was provided for each category
- Clearance rate for Huron County is 20% target is to increase by 5%
- Traffic stats for South Huron 30 R.I.D.E programs were conducted during the month of December
- Traffic complaints have increased overall
- 2 impaired driving charges were laid in South Huron
- Noted that impaired by drugs is increasing throughout the County
- Focus Patrols Vaccination clinics
- Food Drive held at Hansen's YIG Auxiliary members participated in this event
- Calls for service billing summary report was discussed
- Increase in sexual assaults being reported COVID could affect occurrences by circumstances that create opportunities discussing means in which to combat this issue
- Domestics have increased year over year South Huron increased by 8 providing enhanced assistance to the victims of this crime
- Homelessness is being tracked to get them help that is needed number put to this issue
- Sudden death and overdose none for the month of December
- OPIOID overdose 4 deaths between Dec 4, 2021 and December 20, 2021 in the County which is very concerning – troubling trend not specific to South Huron – provide increased awareness through messaging and education
