History of the Pool

- Built in 1977 by Kirkton-Woodham Community, a valued community resource
- Strongly supported by community and surrounding areas
- Management transferred to Blanshard and Usborne Townships late1980s
- With Township amalgamation, the pool was entrusted to Municipality of South Huron(MoSH), Township of Perth South(Perth South) and local Volunteer Kirkton-Woodham Swimming Pool Committee (Pool Committee) under Joint Use Agreement
- ► Three partners worked collaboratively to support the community and valued resource, the Kirkton-Woodham Pool
- ► Historically shared fiscal and management responsibilities between MoSH, Perth South and Pool Committee (Kirkton-Woodham Management Team)

- MoSH and Perth South to hold annual meeting with Pool Committee to speak to current and future operations of the pool
- All partners (MoSH, Perth South and Pool Committee) must be involved in all budgeting, operations, research and implementation of a AODA Capital Plan and future plans for the pool

- Collaboratively plan between MOSH, Perth South and KW Pool Committee to develop Capital Plan for Refurbishment
