

The Corporation of the Municipality of South Huron

By-Law #25-2022

Being a by-law to authorize the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Thames Road Elimville Community Park Committee (The Committee) to formalize a working relationship to coordinate and sustain a multi-use park so that it can continue offering a publicly-accessible green space for the people of South Huron and beyond.

Whereas the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001 provides under Section 5(1) that the powers of a Municipality shall be exercised by its Council and under Section 5(3) provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by By-Law; and

Whereas the Municipality of South Huron deems it desirable to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Thames Road Elimville Community Park Committee to formalize a working relationship with the Thames Road Elimville Community Park Committee and assist in a sustainable publicly-accessible green space for the people of South Huron and beyond.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of South Huron enacts as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of South Huron hereby enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Thames Road Elimville Community Park Committee identified as Schedule "A" attached hereto; and
2. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding between the Municipality of South Huron and the Thames Road Elimville Road Community Park Committee, identified as Schedule "A" and attached hereto; and
3. That By-Law #30-2019 is hereby repealed.
3. That this By-Law takes effect upon the date of final passing.
