Re: By-Law 33-2022 - Appoint Municipal By-Law Enforcement

Officers

The purpose of the By-Law is to rescind the current by-law to ensure that current employees of the Municipality of South Huron are authorized to enforce certain municipal by-laws and to rescind the previous By-Law was enacted in 2015, being By-Law #40-2015. The following items have been updated from the previous by-law:

- 1. Appointments are made by "position" rather than name reducing the need to reappoint for any staff turnover;
- 2. Certain appointments are for the purposes of enforcing specific By-Laws as listed in Column 2 (Applicable By-Laws) of Schedule A;
- 3. Inclusion of sections 3 and 4 to provide entry to land provisions for authorized municipal enforcement officers in the case that current municipal by-laws provisions do not include.
