Tenders for the above-noted project closed electronically by the Municipality on Thursday May 25, 2022 @ 2:00pm local (Exeter) time, through the electronic website Bids & Tenders: https://bids.bidsandtenders.ca/Module/Tenders/en

Immediately afterward, .pdf's of the two submitted bids were forwarded to our office by the Municipality. Within the Municipality's Request For Tender document, the following items were required to be submitted by all bidders:

- Completed Schedule "A" Items and Prices
- Bidder Information Form
- Ability and Experience Form
- Subcontractor Form
- Form of Tender and Agreement
- Scanned copy of the Bid Deposit (Certified Cheque or Bid Bond) OR Digital Bid Bond
- Scanned Copy of the Agreement to Bond OR Digital Agreement to Bond



### Review of Bid No. 1 - Submitted by Elgin Contracting and Restoration Ltd.:

- This contractor was present at the mandatory pre-bid site visit
- All required submitted items were provided and completed. The bid is considered bona-fide.
- Recognized the 2 Municipality issued Tender Addendums
- Of the 3 identified projects submitted with the "Ability & Experience Form" none of them identified any work to do with arenas. Further, the largest value project identified was only \$3.6M. This does represent a concern. We would recommend that the Municipality reach out to the references identified to discuss this Bidder's performance. Item 1.16 of the Municipality's Request for Tender, does state the Municipality can reject a bid on the basis it does not deem the bidder capable of performing the work, however there have been many case law precedents where Owner's, attempting to not accept the lowest bid, have been successfully sued by the low bidder. The reasons are complex but the basic reasoning is if you allow a firm to bid, unless there is a designated, specific scoring system identified and the results of the same can be provided to the bidder to substantiate such a position, you have to accept their bid. Prequalification avoids this. Should the Municipality decide to pursue this course of action, we would recommend it first be discussed with your Legal Dept.
- The submitted "Subcontractor Information Form" identified only Clark Multi-Trade as the Mechanical & Electrical Subcontractor. Given the scope of this project (e.g. poured concrete, masonry, structural steel, dasher boards, etc...) it is doubtful that this is the only subcontractor this bidder has subcontracted. However, again to try to disqualify the bidder based on the contents of this page we believe would represent a legal challenge and should the Municipality decide to pursue this course of action, we would recommend it first be discussed with your Legal Dept.

### Review of Bid No. 2 - Submitted by **Dicocco Contractors 2015 Inc.:**

- This contractor was present at the mandatory pre-bid site visit
- The required "Agreement to Bond" was not submitted. Further, the specific page identifying this requirement was also not included in this bidder's submission. As such this bid is considered nonbona fide.
- Of the 3 identified projects submitted with the "Ability & Experience Form" none of them identified any work to do with arenas. Further, 2 of the project identified were under \$1M in value. This does represent a concern. We would recommend that the Municipality reach out to the references identified to discuss this Bidder's performance. Item 1.16 of the Municipality's Request for Tender, does state the Municipality can reject a bid on the basis it does not deem the bidder capable of performing the work, however there have been many case law precedents where Owner's, attempting to not accept the lowest bid, have been successfully sued by the low bidder. The reasons are complex but the basic reasoning is if you allow a firm to bid, unless there is a designated, specific scoring system identified and the results of the same can be provided to the bidder to substantiate such a position, you have to accept their bid. Prequalification avoids this. Should the Municipality decide to pursue this course of action, we would recommend it first be discussed with your Legal Dept.
- The submitted "Subcontractor Information Form" did not identify any sub-contractors stating they would be provided with the bid breakdown. Again, to disqualify the bidder based on the contents of this page we believe would represent a legal challenge and should the Municipality decide to pursue this course of action, we would recommend it first be discussed with your Legal Dept.
- Dicocco Contractors 2015 Inc submitted pricing is as follows and calculates correctly:

Based on our review of the submitted bids we recommend the following:

- That the Municipality advise Elgin Contracting and Restoration Ltd to submit the original Bid Bond & Original Agreement to Bond, within the 5 business days identified in the Tender documents
- 2. Should the Municipality decide to proceed with the construction of this project, that they award the project to Elgin Contracting and Restoration Ltd for the following amount:
