We have endured the complete closure of the road for almost 2 years during the construction of the apartment complex which negatively impeded the flow of truck and rv traffic to our business!

During the past 2 years, We watched, many times, how trucks, parked on hwy 4 to come in and use the facilities and grab a coffee/food, almost caused some very serious, potentially life threatening, accidents to themselves and others just because they couldn't pull off the main Hwy to pull in somewhere safer.
