

The Corporation of the Municipality of South Huron

By-Law #62-2022

Being a by-law to authorize an Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement with the Her Majesty the Queen in the right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Tourism, Culture and Sport to support the Exeter Rodeo.

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, as amended*, provides under Section 5(1) that the powers of a Municipality shall be exercised by its Council and under Section 5(3) provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by By-Law; and

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, as amended* provides under Section 9 that the municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act; and

Whereas the Municipality of South Huron deems it expedient to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in order to receive funds in support of the Exeter Rodeo 2022 Event.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of South Huron enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in the right of as represented by the Minister of Tourism, Culture and Sport and the Municipality of South Huron, identified as Schedule 'A' and attached hereto.
2. That Schedule 'A' shall form an integral part of this By-Law.
3. That authority to make administrative changes to this by-law that do not change the intent are delegated to the Chief Administrative Officer or their Designate.
4. That this By-Law takes effect upon the date of final passing.

Read a third time and passed this 20th day of September, 2022.
