## **Purpose:**

To provide Council with the Request for Drain Improvement filed by David McCann on behalf of J.A. McCann & Sons Ltd. for the Pickering Municipal Drain on lands located at Lot 28, Concession SB in the Municipality of South Huron, Stephen Ward.

# **Background and Analysis:**

This project was previously applied for and terminated and Council passed resolution #295-2022 which provides the framework for any future submission. Attached to this report is the petition by the property Owner for the Pickering Municipal Drain, as submitted by David McCann, on behalf of J.A. McCann & Sons Ltd. Drain has been attached to the agenda for Council consideration of  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  reading.
