Recommendations:

That South Huron Council receives the report of Jeremy Becker, General Manager of Community & Emergency Services regarding the Building Condition Assessment; and

That South Huron Council accepts the proposal from IRC Building Sciences Group for the delivery of a building condition assessment report in the amount of \$49,500.00 plus HST.

Purpose:

Background and Analysis:

On February 16, 2023, a Request for Proposal (RFP) 001-2023 was issued for the provision of completing a building condition assessment for the Municipality of South Huron.

The closing date for the RFP was March 15, 2023. At closing, a total of 7 submissions were received. This request was a two step process with the technical submission kept separate from the cost structure for the services.

Proposals were received from Artas Engineering & Design, Cambium Inc, Englobe Corp, IRC Building Sciences Group, McIntosh Perry Consulting Engineers Ltd., SLBC INC, WSP Canada Inc.

The results were reviewed by the General Manager of Community & Emergency Services, The Community Services Supervisor & The Acting Director of Finance/Treasurer. The results of the proposals are outlined below.
