2024 BUDGET PRIORITIES

- Maintain current service levels
- Continue investment in capital assets through;
 - Capital plan 10-year capital plan
 - Capital replacement reserve
 - Increased Asset Management Levy
- Finish what we started
 - Dedicating funds towards completing projects such as the extended Corbett Line paving and the Port Blake Revitalization Project



BUDGET PRESSURES

ASSET MANAGEMENT

- Infrastructure deficit
- Annual Capital Requirements to maintain
- Inflation index
- Contribution to reserves for future replacement

COST OF LIVING

- Current year CPI is 3.6% for Sept 2023
- Impacts on gravel prices, vehicle costs, fuel, utilities, benefits, etc.

NO ASSESSMENT INCREASE

- Re-assessment deferred since 2021
- Impact of hike in real estate prices unknown
- Ontario government to conduct review of property assessment and taxation system


STAFFING

- Minimum wage increases
- Difficulties recruiting staff and filling positions
- Overall wage/benefits increases due to grid movements and COLA increases


- Commitment to Asset Management program


