Why We Engage in an Annual Planning Process

Council's Strategic Priorities serve as a roadmap for the Municipality

- Council engages in an annual process to assess ongoing commitments, identify new projects and determine priorities that would best support the achievement of Council goals.
- Through this process, Council confirms its vision, mission and guiding principles, and identifies the strategic priorities, objectives and key actions staff will focus on to support our community's needs, today and into the future



How We establish our Priorities and Plans

- Multi Year Council develops the Council Priorities to guide the direction of the corporation for the term of Council. Council provides overall direction to guide decisions, projects, and initiatives undertaken during the term.
- **Annually** Staff will integrate the strategic priorities into the Annual Workplans and Budgets. This annual review will ensure that work plans remain in alignment with Council's strategic priorities.
- Weekly/Daily Departmental and individual work plans define the specific steps that staff will take to advance strategic objectives and measure progress while ensuring efficient and effective use of resources.

Council's Decision-Making Framework

Step 1 - Confirm Council's role in the issue:

- Council owns the issue (e.g., aligned with mandate, legislative requirement, etc.)
- Council is an active partner in the matter
- Council could be an advocate for the issue

Step 2 – Apply decision-making criteria (see next slide)

Step 3 – Confirm capacity to address issue

Resources are available – human, financial, etc.



Decision-Making Framework

Criteria	Questions to Consider	Weighting
Outcome-focused	 Extent to which the issue/option is aligned with the overall vision and current priorities of the Municipality Extent to which clear process and outcome indicators are identified and measurable 	15
Financial Impact/Affordability	 Extent to which short term (<3 years) affordability and value for money are demonstrated by this issue/option Extent to which long term (3+ years) affordability and value for money are demonstrated by this issue/option 	30
Forward-looking	 Extent to which the issue/option will help achieve social, environmental, and/or economic health for future generations Extent to which the issue/option is proactive in nature, providing a forward-looking solution and intended results 	20
Finish what is started	 Extent to which the issue/option relates to and optimizes an ongoing (previously actioned) priority of Council 	10
Needs-based	• Extent to which this issue/option meets a clearly identified need within the population and community we serve	10
Leveraging partnerships	 Extent to which the issue/option appropriately leverages relevant partnerships including community partnership, surrounding municipalities, and varying levels of government 	15
