# **Report Highlights**

 The Active Transportation Study will review sidewalks, sidewalk policies, bike lanes, cycling strategy and recreation trails.

- The RFP Review Committee evaluated all proposals received and determined that the proposal received from R.J. Burnside ranked the highest.
- Grant funding has been secured from Infrastructure Canada in the amount of \$24,000 and the balance will be funded from the Transportation Services Operating Budget.

## **Context and Background**

The Request for Proposal for an Active Transportation Study was posted on the Bids&tenders on August 14, 2024. The Request for Proposal closed on September 11, 2024 at 2:00pm and four proposals were received by the Municipality. This Request for Proposal was a "two envelope" process, with the technical submission separately from the budget/fee structure for the cost of professional services.

This was a digital process, with online proposal submissions and the opening recorded on Zoom. The digital files containing the technical portion of the proposal were opened by Katie Rowe, Asset Management Analyst as witnessed by Mayor George Finch; Mannat Kaur, Financial Analyst; and Don Giberson General Manager of Infrastructure and Development.

The second digital files containing the budget/fee structure for the cost of professional services remained unopened until after the technical portion of the proposal was reviewed and scored by the RFP Review Committee. The second digital files were subsequently opened by Katie Rowe, Asset Management Analyst on September 17, 2024.

Proposals were received from R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited, LEA Consulting Ltd., ConceptDash Inc., and EXP Services Inc. The technical proposals were evaluated and scored by a RFP Committee comprised of Amanda Johnston, Manager of Community Services, Shane Timmermans, Manager of Transportation Services and Don Giberson, General Manager of Infrastructure and Development. The Proposals were evaluated based on the criteria set out in the Request for Proposal and in accordance with the Procurement of Goods and Services By-Law.

All proposals were found to be in general conformance with the submission requirements. The technical proposals were evaluated and scored by the RFP Review Committee prior to opening the digital files containing the budget/fee structure for the proposals. Based on a review of technical proposals and budget/fee structures, proposals submitted received the following rankings:

## **Discussion and Staff Recommendation(s)**

Staff recommend the award of a professional services contract to R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited, as their proposal was ranked the highest as evaluated by the RFP Committee; meets the expectations of the study timelines; and the cost is in the ballpark of the budget assigned to this project.

# **Impact Analysis**

#### **Financial Impact:**

The cost of this study is included in the 2024 Transportation Services Operating Budget and the amount allocated was \$40,000. Of this amount, \$24,000 was to be funded by an Active Transportation grant from Infrastructure Canada and the balance (ie. \$16,000) was to be funded by the Municipality. The total cost of the Active Transportation Study, including non-recoverable HST is \$46,876.35 is \$6,876.35 higher than the amount allocated in the budget. However, there are sufficient funds in the 2024 Transportation Services Operating Budget to cover the additional costs. The following is a summary of the cost breakdown from the recommended proponent:
