5.1 Use of Remaining Funds

As follow-up to items discussed at the November 13, 2024 Committee meeting, staff provided estimate costs for an accessible pathway, swing and picnic table, and advised that options for an accessible pathway would be reviewed by the Huron County Accessibility Advisory Committee for recommendations. Staff advised there is currently no servicing at the Centralia Park for water fountain for the dog park (water services were decommissioned when the building was demolished).

The Committee discussed proposed amenities and mentioned there is a community donor available in the event the balance of funds in reserve does not cover the recommended projects.
